Official Rules of the Heftiest Pumpkin Weight-Off

Date: Saturday, Oct. 17, 2009

Recreation Park • Recreation Dr., Auburn

Time: All entries must be officially received in Recreation park by 8:30 AM

Entrants receive an Auburn Community Festival T-Shirt

Entry Limitations:

No more than two pumpkins per family may enter. Each specimen must be grown and cared for by the exhibitor. Only one (1) cash prize will be awarded per family. Schools are encouraged to enter as classrooms, clubs and student bodies.

Site officials reserve the right to properly reclassify specimens entered in this event.

Specimen must be healthy and undamaged. The vine must be trimmed to one inch from the stem or stalk of the specimen. No carrying device, pallet or otherwise foreign material may be included in the weighing. Official rules available upon request.

Special notes and restrictions:

Entrants are required to be present for the competition and awards presentation. Weights will be recorded in halfpound increments. In the event of a tie in any category, specimens of equal weight will be declared co-winners, and the cash awards appropriate for their corresponding placements in that category will be totaled and divided equally between the winners. All entries remain in park for public display until at least 4 PM.

Delivery of Entries/Registration Deadline

There is no entry fee. All entry forms must be submitted between 7 AM and 9 AM on Saturday,

October 17 in Recreation Park, Recreation Dr., Auburn.

All specimens must be accompanied by their owners with completed entry form, and must arrive at Recreation park from 7 AM to 9 AM on Saturday, October 17 in order to participate. Large specimens should be brought on pallets; Festival personnel will be on hand to assist entrants in positioning entries.

Weighing:

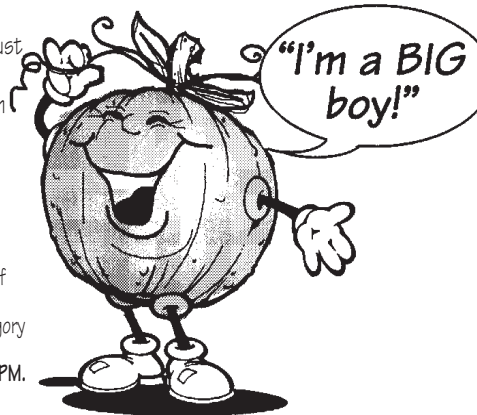
9 AM to 11 AM, Saturday, Oct. 17

An independent jury of selected judges will officiate. This event is meant to be an enjoyable experience for the public. Decisions made by the Auburn Community Festival judges are final.
